

Due to new Money Laundering regulations and requirements, if you wish to offer, bid or buy at auction, Jones Peckover are now required by law to take and verify your identity and address, despite any previous or existing business relationship you may have or have had, with us.

It will now be a requirement to register at each and every auction and to produce one item from list A and one item from List B below. Items must be the originals or copies certified by a recognised professional individual such as a Doctor, solicitor, Accountant or member of another professional body. We **cannot accept** photocopies of documents that have not been certified.

If you are intending to bid either by telephone or by proxy bid, we will require this information **before** the day of the auction. If we have not received the required ID, we will be unable to bid on your behalf.

If you are planning to make a bid at the auction, you must bring 2 items of ID with you to show our staff when you register.

If you are bidding on behalf of a company, you will also need to bring a copy of the Certificate of Incorporation, a list of directors and a letter of authority to make the bid on company letterhead, signed by a company director prior to signing the contract.

You can register and verify your ID in in the following ways:

- Bring your original documents to the office before the auction and we will verify them there and register you
- Register your documents at the Auction. You will need to arrive by 6pm to allow sufficient time
- Please note certified ID – ie ID that is certified by your solicitor, accountant, doctor or other professional body can be e-mailed to us directly from them with a confirmatory note. Send to: denbigh@jonespeckover.com

Items to verify your ID- one item from List A (Photo ID)+one item from List B (Proof of Address)

List B – Proof of Address

Current, signed passport	Current full Uk/EU photo driving licence (if not being used as identity document)
Current full Uk/EU photo driving licence	Utility bill issued within the last 3 months
Valid ID card	Recent bank / building society/mortgage/or credit card statement (paper copy not a download)
Firearm or Shotgun Certificate	MHRC Tax Notification
Residency permit issued by the Home Office to EU National	Recent Council Tax Bill
